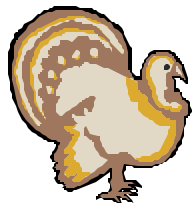
## New things at the Pack Meeting

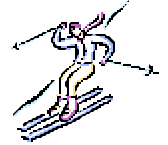
