## JUNE 10TH PICNIC AT BUENA PARK

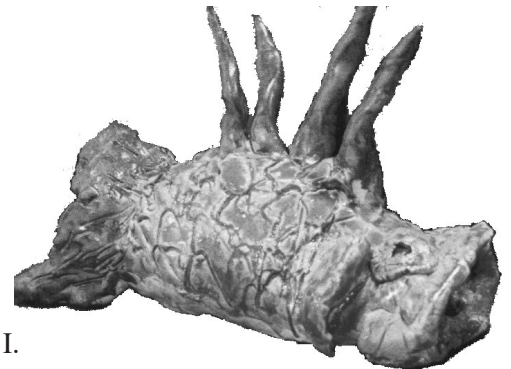
