## June 3, 2017 Golf Outing Fundraiser Information

Hi Everyone,

I hope that everyone has had a good time in Cub Scouts so far this year. It's that time of year again that we need to start thinking about our Golf Outing in June at Eagle Springs Golf Course. This is a **BIG** involvement for all members of Pack 54. What do we need you to do?

This is the **largest fund-raiser** our Pack does each year. Due to the success of this fundraiser the pack was able to cover the cost for each scout to do some amazing things this past year. - - A waterpark day trip to Country Springs, an overnight stay at the Milwaukee Museum, a trip to the Shedd Aquarium in Chicago, some classes at Discovery World to help scouts with requirements and electives, and other fun activities. We also sponsored a local family for Christmas, held a carnival with prizes, and participated in River Rats, which we will be doing again this year. Along with all of this we had the Pinewood Derby and Rain Gutter Regatta, where the scouts won and earned many awards.

In order to continue with these big events and do other things, we need each family's support for the golf event. This helps us to **not** have any additional fundraising, other than the Wreath and Popcorn Sales we have at the beginning of the year. So please do everything you can to help make this a successful fund-raiser this year!

Each family would ideally provide the following:

1-2 raffle items

1 hole sponsor

1 foursome group of golfers

1 volunteer the day of the event (unless you're golfing)

1 bottle of alcohol or drink add-in (Examples: 2-Liter Coke, Margarita mix, etc...)

**Raffle Items** – These can be baskets, gift certificates – anything that you feel would be a desirable item an individual would buy raffle tickets to win. Ask your employer and your favorite businesses or pick up something to donate. Last year we had some really great prizes. **Please have all raffle items turned in by June 1st** to the Beilke family. Bring items to a den meeting, committee meeting or drop things off at the Beilke residence at 702 Andrew Street, Eagle.

**Hole Sponsors** - A hole sponsor gets a sign displayed on the golf course to show their support for Cub Scouts and advertise their business (They can choose to use their own sign or we will make a basic sign for them). *The cost to be a hole sponsor is \$100.* This is huge profits! How do we get hole sponsors? We ask our employers, business owners, groups like the Lions and Legion, friends and family. We have set up a **signup sheet on Shutterfly under "2017 Golf Fundraiser"** where you can enter the name of the sponsor and your name. **All hole sponsors need to be identified and have paid their \$100 fee by May 22nd.**

**Golfers** – We need golfers. We have a **signup sheet on Shutterfly under "2017 Golf Fundraiser"** where you can enter the golfing foursomes. Ask your friends, neighbors anyone who would like to golf and support our Cub Scouts. **The event fee for golfers is \$85.** This includes a golf cart, lunch served at the turn, a sit down steak dinner, a chance to win a "Hole in One" Prize, and other special hole contests. We can have up to, I believe, 30 foursomes. Boy, if you do the math that adds up to a lot of \$\$\$\$!

**Volunteers** – We will need registration personnel, special hole supervisors, ticket seller and more. If you are able to help out, we have put a **signup sheet on Shutterfly as "2017 Help At Golf Fundraiser"** please take the time to sign up to help our Pack.
