November Pack Meeting: Song and Skit Night

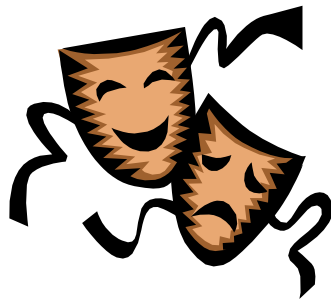

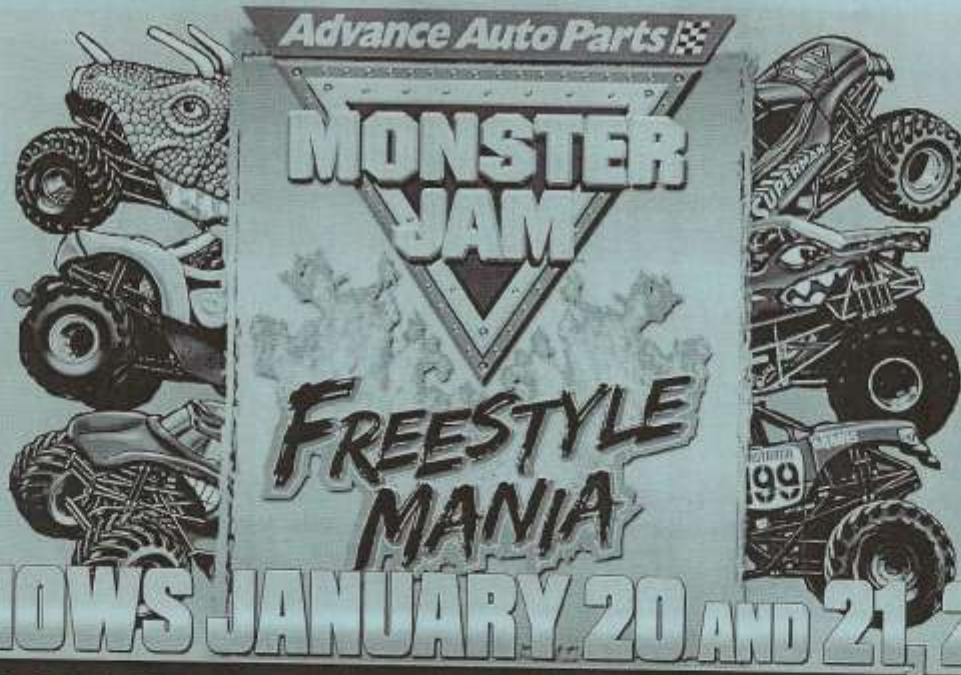
