ANNOUNCEMENTS

- Fall fundraising information will be distributed at the Pack meeting. Products include Pecatonica River Popcorn, Berres Brother's Coffee, and Winter Woods Wreaths. Orders and money are due at the next Pack meeting on Thursday, October 16. The Pack receives 40% of sales. As an incentive to do their best, scouts receive money into their scout accounts based on the amount they sell:
 - Sell more than \$100 = receive 10% of total in the scout account
 - More than \$200 = 20%
 - More than \$300 = 30%
- Dues renewal takes place in the fall. Sign-up at the back table during the Pack meeting and share t-shirt size. We submit dues to the Council by the end of the calendar year. This year, dues are \$50 per scout which includes
 - rechartering fees
 - a new Pack t-shirt
 - Pack expenses, and
 - \$20 for the den account (to offset den expenses such as outings).
- Dues can be paid now, but will be due after the Product Sales due date to allow scouts to raise funds in their scout account.
