**Boy Scouts** are invited to engage in the exciting world of Science, Technology, Engineering, and Mathematics!

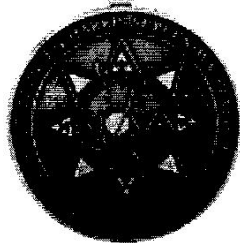
**Scholarship Merit Badge** will be able to be earned from 8AM-8:30AM by bringing documentation of achievement/improvement from their local school.
