Prerequisites and Blue Cards - Scouts may be required to complete certain merit badge requirements prior to OC to complete the merit badge that weekend. Prerequisites will be posted on Troop 175's website in early 2018, and Scouts are expected to turn them in Friday night of the event. If your troop is attending Saturday only, prerequisites are due by 7:30am that morning. Scouts must also turn in signed merit badge applications (blue cards) to their counselors.

Citizenship in the Community – Scouts must be at least 13 years old to participate. This merit badge requires a lot of homework to be completed the month before OC. Look for frequent emails from the merit badge counselors.

Cooking + Signs, Signals & Codes – Scouts must be First Class Rank or higher. This is an off-site, all day session (7:30am – 4:30pm) where both merit badges are earned. Scouts will be making their own lunch as part of the requirements.
