

Digital Technology – Scouts will need to bring their own device for accessing the Internet, like a laptop or tablet. Troop will need to plan for a safe place to store their Scout's devices while they're not in use, like putting them in a locked car.

Emergency Preparedness - This merit badge requires completion of the First Aid merit badge prior to our event. Unfortunately, you cannot register for First Aid in the morning and Emergency Prep in the afternoon.

Rank Advancement First Aid & Totin' Chip – Perfect for first year Scouts! First aid requirements will be covered for Tenderfoot, Second Class, and First Class along with Totin' Chip.

Shooting Sports - Registration is limited to one Shooting Sports merit badge (Archery, Shotgun or Rifle) per Scout. Scouts must be at least 12 years old to participate in shotgun or rifle at this event. It's strongly recommended that Scouts weigh at least 90lbs to participate in the Shotgun merit badge. There will be a mandatory safety clinic given **Friday night** for all Scouts participating in shooting sports. If you are planning to attend Saturday only, do not sign up for any shooting sports merit badges.

Wilderness Survival - This merit badge requires the Scout to make a shelter and sleep in it Saturday night.

2018 Registration Fees

Early Bird Registration (cutoff 2/18/2018): Scouts: \$45.00 Adults: \$20.00 (two adults are free)

Regular Registration (cutoff 4/29/2018): Scouts: \$55.00 Adults: \$30.00 (two adults are free)

Rifle, Shotgun, Cooking/Signs additional fee: \$ 5.00

Registration fees must be submitted with the registration form and are not refundable.

Two adults per unit are free to facilitate two-deep leadership.

Registration fees cover camping, merit badge supplies, Saturday evening program, and Saturday lunch. Your troop should plan the rest of your meals. All troops are required to have two-deep leadership at the event. Once the registration fee and form are received, a confirmation of the registration will be emailed to your troop contact. Merit badges will be assigned in order of registration.
