

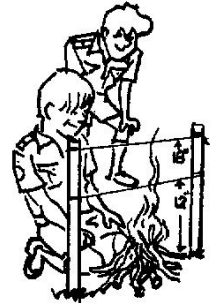

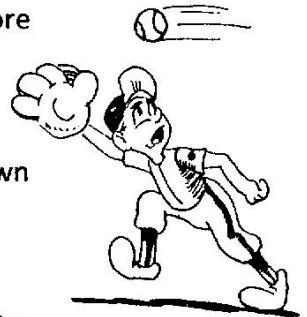
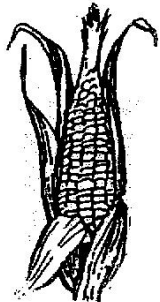


Troop 16 News by Scoutmaster Hep
