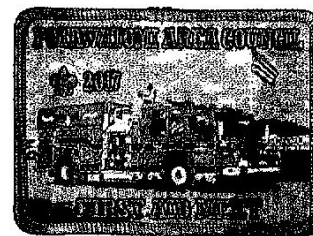




# 2017 MARCH
