

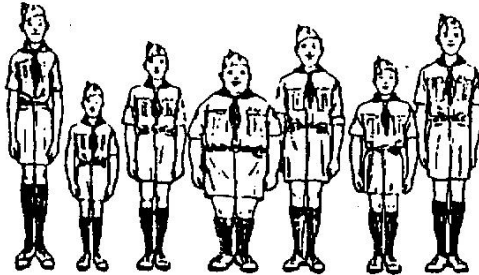


TROOP 16 NEWS
