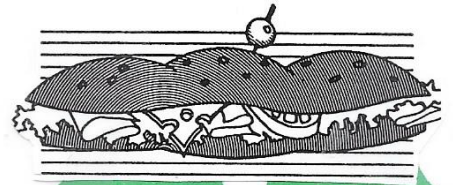

At a meeting Sean D' gave us a competitive chess presentation. At our other meetings we practiced first aid.

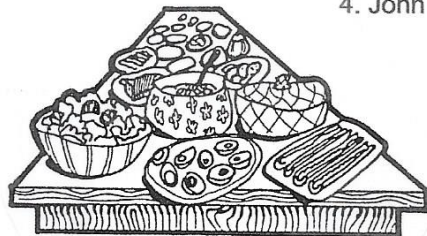
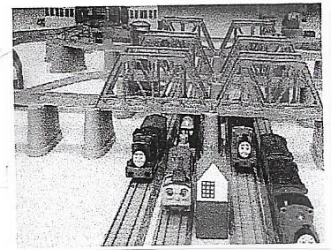
Our new equipment quartermasters are Anthony W, Jacob B, and Zac W. They stow the equipment in the troop room after camping trips.
