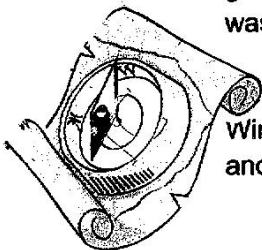


January Troop 16 News
