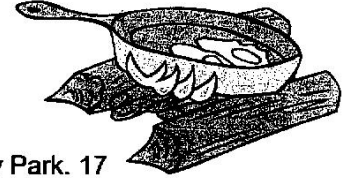

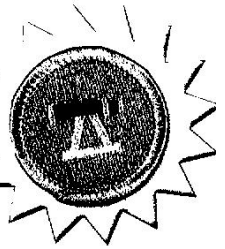
## Troop 16 News By Troop Historian Will M
