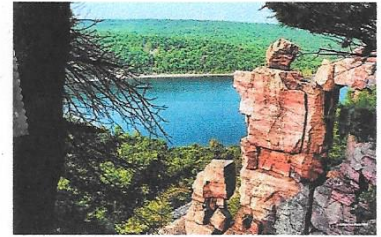

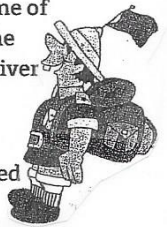


WEBELOS JAMBOREE
