**Leadership & Team Building**

This is a hands-on workshop for older scouts to develop team building and personal performance skills. This is not a death by presentation, but an active participation working with groups to complete activities. Scouts should walk away with a better understanding of communication, importance of working with others, and a clear understanding of how to do your best.

**Prerequisites and Blue Cards** – Scouts may be required to complete certain merit badge requirements prior to OC to complete the merit badge that weekend. Prerequisites will be posted on Troop 175's website in early 2019, and Scouts are expected to turn them in Friday night of the event or emailed prior. If your troop is attending Saturday only, prerequisites are due by 7:30am that morning. Scouts must also turn in signed merit badge applications (blue cards) to their counselors
